Node Registration Facts

You must register your computer to use the FNAL network! There are two types of registration:

- Temporary for visitors (4 days or less).
- Permanent for regular network use.
- Visitors register & get on the network fast!
 - 90% of the registrations take < 3 minutes...
- You must fill out the permanent registration form after 4 days of temporary registration

Temporary Registration

Temporary registration is simple. Just power on your computer, open a web browser and fill in the form. In most cases you can release and renew your DHCP address to use your temporary address. If that doesn't work then it will be taken care of with a quick reboot!

Temporary Registration Address:

Provides full onsite & offsite network access - but it expires at midnight! Re-registration is required each day for a maximum of 5 days. For permanent access you must fill out Miscomp Node Registration Form (all of your hardware addresses must be registered)

Permanent Registration

To permanently register your machine, the following information is required:

- System name
- System administrator
- Hardware information
- Location
- All Ethernet hardware “MAC” addresses
 - This is the 12 digit, hexadecimal unique identifier for each of your network interfaces.
 - A laptop might have **three** MAC addresses: **wireless, wired,** and a **docking station.**
